Speaker Profile :

Professor Alan Hughes is Margaret Thatcher Professor of Enterprise Studies at the Judge Business School, University of Cambridge, Director of the Centre for Business Research (CBR) and of the UK Innovation Research Centre (UK~IRC) (a joint venture between the CBR and Imperial College Business School). He is also a Fellow of Sidney Sussex College, University of Cambridge. He was from 2000–2003 Director of the National Competitiveness Network of the Cambridge–MIT Institute, a joint venture between MIT and the University of Cambridge. He has most recently completed with colleagues at Cambridge a detailed analysis of the role of individual academics in knowledge exchange building on a survey of over 22,000 academics in all disciplines in all UK universities as well as an evaluation of the impact of government funding on university–industry knowledge exchange. He has been since 2004 a member of the UK Prime Minister’s Council for Science and Technology, the UK senior advisory body in this area.
